Background:

The US Code of Federal Regulations, PART 801 -- LABELING, Subpart H--Special Requirements for Specific Devices, Sec. 801.437, User labeling for devices that contain natural rubber; specifically requires that devices, their packaging, or components that are composed of, or contain, natural rubber Latex that comes into contact with humans are to be labeled with a warning statement:

"Caution: This Product Contains Natural Rubber Latex Which May Cause Allergic Reactions."
